Methodology:

The sign of a good journalist is the ability to grasp the facts accurately using their craft skills to deliver a good story. In this one-day course, our trainer will demonstrate OSINT techniques to improve your online research.

Objectives:

- Introduce & demonstrate OSINT techniques that can generate ideas for stories and features, for following leads from news agencies, the police, the public, press conferences and other sources.
- Observe how we research, verify and collate evidence and information to support a story using relevant sources such as the internet, archives, databases, etc.
- See how to verify pictures and video to support stories.
- Look at social media monitoring tools that can be used to obtain current information about ongoing incidents or events.
- See how OSINT can be used to build contacts in many areas to maintain a flow of news.

- An awareness of OSINT techniques to assist in your daily work.
- Skills to analyse social media information regarding incidents and events.
- The ability to identify criminal activity and newsworthy material from the web.
- Skills to build and maintain a full list of contacts and research material to keep a flow of news.
